Minimum Qualifications:

- Have been a resident of Cherokee County for two years preceding the beginning of his or her term of office;
- Be at least 25 years of age;
- Remain a resident of Cherokee County during his or her term of office;
- Be a citizen of the United States;
- Be a registered voter;
- Licensed attorney;
- Member of the Georgia State Bar and in good standing.

Of Note:

- Candidates are subject to a background check;
- Candidates must be approved by the Superior Court of Cherokee County.
